5. Personal life. (girlfriends, wives, children, significant events, etc.)

6. Place he lived, any travels, where he may have moved to, and when.

7, 8, and 9. Career and jobs. (How did he earn money? What did he do for a living during his lifetime? Important events? Who did he work for? For how long? Where did he work?)

10. Date of death and place of death.

11. Cause of death.

12. A Picture of your composer.
